The meeting was convened at 9:00 am and called to order by Commissioner Moore. Roll call was taken.

1. **DISCUSS, REVIEW AND APPROVE:** Ordinance 2020-APR-002: Establishing a curfew to aid in stopping the community spread of the COVID-19 Virus during the period of the Declared Emergency.

Dr. Jenny Whey, Dr. Valerie Wagner and Senator George Munoz commented on the alcohol restrictions of the Ordinance. Comments were also heard from the public.

The Commission took comments from the public who called in to the meeting to make the comments. This meeting was placed on the McKinley County OEM Facebook live virtual site, and citizens were capable of calling a number and a return call was made to receive those comments.

The Commission discussed two versions of the proposed Ordinance 2020-APR-002. During the meeting, the Commissioners proposed changes to the proposed ordinance which changes were made. Ordinance 2020-APR-002 is retitled as "An Ordinance establishing a ban on the sale of certain alcohol products to aid in stopping the community spread of the COVID-19 Virus; and, urging all citizens to choose to self-curfew during certain hours for the period of the declared emergency"

Commissioner Lee made a motion to approve Ordinance 2020-APR-002: An Ordinance establishing a ban on the sale of certain alcohol products to aid in stopping the community spread of the COVID-19 Virus; and, urging all citizens to choose to self-curfew during certain hours for the period of the declared emergency. Commissioner Nelson seconded the motion and requests weekly updates pertaining to the Ordinance. Motion Carried by Roll Call Vote.
