The Special Meeting of the Board was held at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioner's Chambers with the following present/or virtually due to New Mexico COVID-19 orders: Bill Lee - Commissioner; Billy Moore - Commissioner; Doug Decker - County Attorney; Anthony Dimas - County Manager; Janessa McMahon - Executive Assistant; Ron Silversmith - Sheriffs Dept.; James Maiorano - Sheriffs Dept.; Karneel Bennett - Clerk's Office - Monitor.

The meeting was convened at 10:00 am and called to order by Commissioner Moore. Roll call was taken.

Commissioner Moore - present; Commissioner Lee - present; Commissioner Nelson - Excused.

NOTE: The Board of County Commissioners has the authority to adopt ordinances as established in State Law - N.M.S.A. §4-37-7. Typically, a proposed ordinance must be published in a newspaper for two weeks before it can be considered. However, N.M.S.A. §4-37-7(C) abrogates that requirement when there is an "emergency declared by the Board of County Commissioners to be an immediate danger to the public health, safety and welfare of the county." The Board of County Commissioners did, by Resolution No. MAR-20-029 make a "Declaration of a Health Emergency" regarding COVID-19.

1. **DISCUSS, REVIEW, AND APPROVE: ORDINANCE 2020-APR-003 AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE USE OF MASKS IN PUBLIC DUE TO COVID-19 TO AID IN STOPPING THE COMMUNITY SPREAD OF THE COVID-19 VIRUS.**

The Commission took comments from the public who called in to the meeting to make the comments. This meeting was placed on the McKinley County OEM Facebook live virtual site, and citizens were capable of calling a number and a return call was made to receive those comments.



Commissioner Lee "Said I", Commissioner Moore "Said I". None - OPPOSED.




