BOTVIN-LIFE SKILLS

Botvin-Life Skills a validated substance abuse prevention program proven to reduce the risk of alcohol, tobacco, drug abuse & violence by targeting the major social & Psychological factors that promote the initiation of substance use & other risky behaviors. The Comprehensive & exciting program provides adolescents & young teens with the confidence & Skills necessary to successfully handle challenging situations.

CASE MANAGEMENT

The Case Management Program is a component made up of longer term services based upon assessing the needs of the client and the clients family. When appropriate, the Case Management will arrange, coordinate, monitor, evaluate, and advocate for a package of multiple services to meet the clients complex needs.

Participation in the Case Management program lasts for a period appropriate to the needs of the individual, typically ranging from 2-6 months.

The Case Management Program accepts referrals from Law Enforcement, Gallup-Mckinley County Schools/Hearing Authority, other area schools within McKinley County, the Juvenile Probation Office (JPO), Behavioral Health Evaluators, and concerned parents/self referrals.

BOYS COUNCIL / GIRLS CIRCLE

Boys Council is a model of structured, gender relevant support groups for boys & young men from 9-18 years. Boys Council aims to promote boys natural strengths & to increase their options about being a male in today's world.

Girls Circle is a model for girls, ages 9-18 years old. It integrates relational theory, resiliency practices & skill training in a format designed to increase positive connection, personal & collective strengths and competence in girls.

SAFETY FIRST

Safety First Curriculum is a harm reduction-based Drug Education for adolescents. This safety first is focused on real drug education for teens, including careful examination of the impact of the war on drugs, failures of abstinence-based teaching models, and the value of having honest conversation with teens in the evolving landscape of drug use and drug policy
