## Case Management

Case management provides juveniles age (12-17) with extra support with referrals to resources and by being there for them. We complete an intake process, mental health evaluation and follow ups.

## Botvin

Botvin is a curriculum that our staff is trained to provide. The purpose is to help juveniles learn how to make healthier life decisions. This typically taught in school and to small groups.

## Boys Council/Girls Circle

Boys Council is a model of structured, gender relevant support groups for boys & young men from 9-18 years. Boys Council aims to promote boys natural strengths & to increase their options about being a male in today's world. Girls Circle is a model for girls, ages 9-18 years old. It integrates relational theory, resiliency practices & skill training in a format designed to increase positive connection, personal & collective strengths and competence in girls.

## Safety First

Safety First is a curriculum that focuses on harm reduction strategies. It is taught to small groups or in school.
